

2018-19 CSW Terms and Conditions*

As a 2018-19 CSW Scholar, you must:

1. Have health insurance during the entirety of the program (September to May);
2. Be a registered sophomore, junior or senior at a university or college located in one of the following counties: Alamance, Chatham, Durham, Guilford, Orange, or Wake;
3. Have a passion for women's human rights advocacy and addressing local (North Carolina) and global problems;
4. Be able to travel to New York City for CSW 63* for the full seven day period: March 9, 2019 - March 16, 2019 (*full funding for this trip is provided);
5. Be in New York City for the full seven day period, and participate in UN CSW meetings and NGO Forum panels from 8:00am to 6:00pm, and attend WomenNC group meetings between 6:00pm and 8:00pm daily;
6. Be fully committed to the CSW session: This means no school projects, job interviews, or personal visits during your time in New York
7. Be available to participate in the Mentor-Mentee matching ("speed-dating") event on Monday, September 17 from 6:00 - 7:30 PM
8. Be available to participate in the WomenNC three annual events on November 15, 2018; February 28, 2018 or March 7, 2019; and April 11, 2019
9. Be available for media interviews as opportunities arise
10. Attend all sessions held by WomenNC as indicated on the timeline;
11. Complete research and prepare a 10-12 page Gender Equity Status Report and a PowerPoint presentation on a topic relevant to women's human rights both locally in NC communities and globally;
12. Prepare an executive summary (1-2 pages) of research report for public distribution
13. Present your Gender Equity Status Report to local politicians identified by WomenNC to advocate for change;
14. Present your research findings to Durham County Women's Commission, Durham Mayor's Council for Women, and/or other Women's Governmental Advisory Boards as identified and necessary
15. Complete a five page reflection paper and 5 minute presentation on your experience at CSW due on April 4, 2019;
16. Be able to attend workshops in Raleigh for up to four hours on the Sunday afternoons of September 23, 2018, October 21, 2018, January 27, 2019, and February 17, 2019 and attend dress rehearsals [February 28 or March 7, 2019] for final presentations; attendance at local NC Coalition for CEDAW meetings may be scheduled in lieu of workshop sessions at the discretion of CSW Chair and notice will be given in advance;

17. Submit the following documents/reports in compliance with the instructions given and in a timely manner in compliance with the timeline below:
 - a. Three Blogs: October 1, November 22, February 24
 - b. Blog each night in NY while at CSW [March 9 - March 16]
 - c. Finalize research topic/question and plan of action/outline by October 21st
 - d. First draft of research completed by December 14
 - e. Final draft of research by January 11
 - f. Presentation with slideshow ready by January 18
 - g. First live practice of presentation February 17 [public speaking workshop]
 - h. Annual fundraising event: February 28 or March 7, 2019
 - i. Final reflection presentation: April 11, 2019
 - j. Present to local elected officials/Women's Advisory boards [April/May 2019]
18. Organize and conduct two small group local presentations after your return from CSW regarding your research and experience at the UN;
19. Submit evaluation surveys [initial evaluation and final evaluation]
20. Provide a short annual summary for 2019, 2020, 2021 of the: work/study you're pursuing, any activities you are doing related to women's human rights, impact of WomenNC and/or CSW Leadership Program on your life. This helps WomenNC to gauge the effectiveness and impact of the CSW Leadership Program on your future academic and career choices and success; and
21. Provide updated email and phone contact information for three years following the CSW Leadership Program;
22. Agree that all writings, reports, documents, papers, blogs, recordings, likenesses produced of or by the Scholars, may be reproduced and used by WomenNC for future presentations and promotion of WomenNC and the CSW Leadership program.
