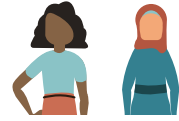

Cities and Counties for the Elimination of Discrimination Against Women

Partner with colleges and universities, County and City Women's Commissions and government officials, local organizations, and communities to identify needs and concerns

Use research by university students in partnership with RTI's Global Gender Center to develop a framework to analyze the current state of gender issues across the state: Gender Analysis

Provide an annual "Action Plan" for local governments for accountability, policy change, and resource allocation for gender equity

Local college students conduct independent research on topics of gender equity in NC

Program provides over 500 hours of training and mentorship by RTI's Global Gender Center in research, advocacy, public speaking, and education

Scholars present research and policy recommendations to local, state, and national audiences. Scholars communicate findings to an international officials and activists at the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women

Results



12 member NC Coalition for CEDAW formed

Initiated a sustainable model to improve the status of women in NC.

Coordinated over 6,000 hours of volunteer work annually.



Trained 53 university students, 20 interns, and 220 high school students.

Directly impacted 40,000+ people across local communities, the state, nation, and globe.
